III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the commissioners aforefaid shall afcertain and value what Who shall afdamages fuch road running through any perfons land shall amount to, which shall be paid to the certain daperion to damaged by the parties petitioning for, or wishing faid road.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That all perfons subject to labour on, or otherwise keep in repair, Persons to be public roads, and living on the following tracts or parcels of land, to wit: The Cove, Long fublect to an Bottom, and lot number three thousand five hundred and eighty-one, shall be subject to an overfeer, to be appointed as other overfeers are appointed in Allegany county, and shall labour on, or otherwise keep in repair, the road aforesaid, and shall not be liable to labour on, or keep in repair, any other public road in faid county.

V. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid road shall not exceed twenty feet in width, and shall Read not to exnot go through any orchard or meadow, unless with the approbation of the owner or owners feet wide. thereof.

An ACT to establish and confirm certain acts done by persons holding offices of Passed Jan. 15. trust and profit under the government of the United States.

WHEREAS persons in several of the counties of this state have continued to act as associate Preamble. courts therein, after having accepted offices of profit and trust under the government of the United States, and doubts are entertained as to the validity of all acts done before or by them,

H. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That if any person holding an office Certain acts deof profit or trust under the government of the United States, fince the thirtieth day of December, clared valid, seventeen hundred and ninety-one, hath, at the same time, acted as justice of the peace, or as an affociate justice, or as a justice of the orphans courts within this state, under a commission from the executive thereof, that each and every act done by or before such person in the capacity of a justice of the peace, or as affociate justice, or justice of the orphans courts, within the proper limits of his jurisdiction, shall be and the same are hereby declared valid and effectual, to all intents and purposes.

C H A P. LVII.

An ACT to enable the justices of Kent county court to cause to be transcribed Passed Jan. 15. the records and papers therein mentioned.

WHEREAS it is represented to this general affembly, that fundry of the record books and Preamble. other papers belonging to the orphans court of Kent county are much defaced and injured, and by being suffered to remain in their present state they may be entirely useless, and the inhabitants of faid county would be much injured thereby; therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the justices of Kent county court Justices to cause shall and they are hereby authorised and required, to cause all such record books and papers be- records to be longing to the orphans court of faid county as have been defaced and much injured, and fuch as they, in their differetion, may think necessary, to be transcribed into new record books by some person to be appointed by the faid court, and the record so transcribed shall be good in law, to all intents and purposes, as the original records from which they were transcribed

III. And BE IT ENACTED, That the justices of the levy court for the said county are hereby Money to be empowered to affels and levy on the faid county fuch a fum of money as the justices of the county court may direct, to defray the costs and charges arising for transcribing the said records and other papers belonging to the orphans court aforefaid, after the fame shall have been done, in the fame manner as other county charges are imposed and levied, and the same shall, when col-# lected, be paid to the person by whom the same shall be transcribed, for his trouble and expences in performing the duties required by this act.
