CHAP.

fucceffors, appointed in the manner herein after declared, shall and are hereby declared to be one community, corporation and body politic, to have continuation for ever, by the name of The Vilitors of Allegany County School, and by that name to fue and be fued, implead or he impleaded, and to make and have a common ical, and the fame to break, after or renew, when and fo often as they shall think fit.

How vacancies

III. And BE IT ENACTED, That the aforefaid vilitors, and their fuccesfors, or a majority of are to be filled them, faall, at any and at all times, upon the death, relignation, or removal from the county, of any one or more of the vilitors, appoint other fentible and different man or mon of the faid county to be the vifitor or vifitors to fill the vacancy created by the death, refignation or removal, as aforefaid.

Vifitors to make ordinances, &c.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid vifitors, and their faccesfors, or a majority of them, shall have full power and authority to make fundamental ordinances for the government of the school or seminary aforesaid, and the education of the youth, and to appoint such person or persons as they, or a majority of them, may think proper, to be teacher or teachers of the faid school.

Meet twice in

V. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid viritors, and their fuccessors, or a majority of them, each year, &c. shall meet at least twice in each year, at such time as shall be appointed by their own ordinanses, in order to examine the progrets of the students and scholars, and to hear and determine on all tomplaints and appeals, and all matters touching the discipline of the feminary, and the good and wholesome execution of their ordinances, on all which occasions a majority at least of the visitors shall compose a quorum.

And may hold property, &c.

VI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid vifitors, and their fuccesfors, may hold and enjoy. and that they may be apt and capable in law for taking, holding and enjoying, all manors, lands, tenements, rents, fervices, portions, annuities, pensions, with all other inheritances, franchises and possessions whatsoever, of the gift of any person whatsoever that is willing to bestow them, for the use of the school aforesaid, or any other gifts, grants, assignments, legacies or donations of any and all kinds whatever, for the use and benefit of said school.

Ordinances,&c. the affembly.

VII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the ordinances which shall from time to time be made by the to be laid before faid vifitors, and their fuccessors, with an account of their other proceedings, shall, when required, be laid before the general affembly, for their examination and inspection.

Treasurer to pay, &c.

VIII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the treasurer of the western shore shall pay to the aforesaid trustees, or their order, annually, as a public donation, the sum of two hundred dollars, for the purposes of education, the first payment whereof shall be made on the first day of October next for the use and encouragement of the school aforesaid, the sum of two hundred dollars to be an plied at the discretion of the trustees aforesaid.

Passed Jan. 18. An ACT to appoint an agent for the year one thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine.

An agent appointed.

E IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That William Marbury be agent of this D state, to execute the trust and power reposed in him by virtue of this act, from the first day of January, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, until the first day of January, on thousand eight hundred.

To superintend the collection of arrearages, &c.

H. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid agent superintend the collection of all arrearages and balances due from the feveral collectors of the respective counties within this state; and the said agent is hereby authorifed and required to call upon the treasurers of the respective shores so an accurate statement of all arrearages and balances due from such collectors, and such account shall be furnished by the faid treasurers accordingly.

Of balances on the auditor's books, &c.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid agent be authorifed to superintend the collection balances due to the state on the auditor's books, or on open account; and the said agent sha have power to require payment of, and, if necessary, to sue for and recover the same; and the faid agent, with the approbation of the governor and council, may make composition with fuch debtors, and take bonds to the state, with sufficient security, and give time for payment not exceeding two years from the first day of January, seventeen hundred and ninety-nine.

And monies due for duties, Re.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid agent be authorised to superintend the collection all monies due to the state for payal duties, fines, penalties, forseitures and amerciaments, and forfeited recognizances, and for ordinary, retailers and marriage licences, and to require partial ment, and, if necessary, sue for and recover the same; and the said agent may allow for inso vencies, and credit any money that the party is not chargeable with by law, and for his information tion of the law, he may take the advice of the attorney general in writing.

Notice to be given of false. &cc.

V.
