AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid agent, in a convenient time after the receipt of fuch moceedings, that give public notice for the space of twelve weeks, by advertisements to be ingreed in an Easten, Baltimore, Annapolis, Frederick, George-town and Philadelphia news- Agent to give supers, and fee up in public places in the neighbouring counties, that the faid Indian lands afore- public notice, are allotted and intended for public fale, at a certain time and place in Dorchester county, to be mentioned in fuch advertisements, and the faid agent shall attend at the time and place apminted, and shall proceed to expose the said lots to sale by the acre, and the same shall be reproclively struck off to the highest bidder, upon the following terms, and not otherwise: The our chaser shall give bond to this state, with such security as the said agent may approve, for the syment of the faid purchase money, in specie, in sour equal annual instalments, with interest thereon from the day of sale, the lands belonging to the purchasers, and their securities, at the time of fuch fale, shall be bound from the passage of their respective bonds for the payment of the purchase money, or so much thereof as may be due; and on a compliance with the foregoing terms of fale by any purchaser, it shall be lawful for the said agent, and he is hereby authorised and empowered, to execute and acknowledge, in due form of law, a deed of bargain and fale to fuch purchaser for the lot or lots respectively sold, describing the said lot or lots in such deed acfording to the surveyor's certificate thereof, and thereupon, and upon the due enrolment thereof, the right, title and interest, of the state shall thereby be vested in such purchaser, and his heirs, fee-simple; and the said agent shall proceed, in his discretion, to expose the said lots to sale at the time mentioned in faid advertisement, or for sufficient reason may adjourn the sales to such other time or times as shall seem to him adviseable, so as to promote a fair and honest sale of the premises aforefaid.

VIII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That each of the faid commissioners, and the said surveyor, shall Commissioners be entitled to receive three dollars for every day they shall be necessarily employed in the execunon of this trult, and the faid agent shall be entitled to receive a commission of one per cent. on the amount of the sales of the said lots; and the said expences, and all other lawful and reasonble expenditures incurred by virtue of this act, shall be paid by the treasurer of the western hore to the respective parties entitled to receive the same, and the said treasurer shall keep a correct account of all such payments; and the said agent shall keep an account of his proceedings in the premises, and the same, together with the bonds taken in virtue of this act, and the sweral vouchers for payments, and the proceedings and expenditures of the faid commissioners, hell be lodged by them in the treasury of the western shore, and be subject to the inspection of the general affembly when the same shall be required.

IX. And BE IT ENACTED, That the treasurer of the western shore shall be authorised, and he Treasurer to hereby required, after the execution of the trusts herein before mentioned, and the times li- pay, &c. nitted, to pay the orders drawn as aforefaid for the use of the said Indians out of any unappropriated-money in the treasury.

X. AND BE IT ENACTED, That it shall not be lawful for the said Indians to sell, grant, leafe, Indians not to or otherwise dispose of, the lands to be reserved to them by virtue of this act, or any part thereof, for any estate, or in any manner whatsoever; and if any person or persons, after the completion of the contract and agreement aforesaid, shall presume to purchase, lease, or in any manner uke, the faid lands, or any part thereof, of the faid Indians, or any of them, contrary to this ich, such person or persons shall forfeit and pay the sum of two hundred dollars, to be recovered by presentment and indictment in the county court of Dorchester, and his, her, or their estate therein shall be void and of no effect, and the party or parties shall be trespassers, and for such trespass, and for every other trespass in any manner committed upon the said reserved lands, the party or parties shall be liable to be sued in the name of this state, and, on conviction, double damages shall be recovered, and the costs of suit.

XI. PROVEDED NEVERTHELESS, AND BE IT ENACTED, That before any commissioner, appointed Provide, or to be appointed in virtue of this act, shall proceed to execute the trust hereby reposed in him, he shall take an oath, or affirmation, before some justice of the peace of the said county, that he will faithfully and honestly, according to the best of his skill and judgment, execute and perform the several trusts and duties required of him by this act, without affection, partiality or prejudice, and the taking thereof shall be certified by such justice, and transmitted to the treasurer of the western shore, together with the proceedings of the said commissioners; that in case no contract mall be made between the faid commissioners and the faid Indians, under and by virtue of this act, before the first day of August next, that in such case the agent for the time being be authonied, at his discretion, to prosecute a suit or suits at law or equity, as the case may require, to recover the possession of said land, or of any part thereof, to which the state may be entitled.
