Rock of the United States, goods, chattels or personal property whatsoever, by gift, grant or bequest; provided, that the lands which shall be acquired by, and vested in, the said corporation by virtue of this act, shall not exceed the quantity of two hundred acres; and provided also, that the real and personal property acquired by, and vested in, the said corporation, shall not exceed in the whole the yearly value of two hundred pounds current money of Maryland; and the fame lands, tenements, hereditaments and personal property, to give, sell, convey, or otherwise dispose of, as to them shall feem meet, for the use of the faid religious society; and also that the faid trustees, by the name aforefaid, shall be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, defend and be defended, in any fuits or actions in all or any court of jurisdiction within this state; and that it shall and may be lawful for the said trustees, by the name aforefaid, to devile, make, have and use, one common seal to authenticate all and every the acts, deeds and instruments, touching their business, and the same at pleasure to break, alter and renew; and generally, that the faid truffees, by the name aforefaid, shall have, hold and enjoy, all and fingular the rights, privileges, liberties and franchiles, incident and belonging to a private or religious corporation or body politic, as fully and effectually as any other religious corporation or body politic in this state hath right to have, hold and enjoy.

CHAP. LIII.

II. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the first trustees of the faid corporation shall be and consist of the First trustees following perfons, to wit: The reverend Germain Bethufy, pafter of the faid congregation, James appointed, &c. Neale, senior, John Lancaster, John Neale, Henry Hamerlly, Benjamin Lancaster, Thomas Jenkins and Francis Lancaster, members of the said congregation; and the suture trustees of the said corporation shall be and consist of the pastor of the church for the time being, and five lay members of the congregation of Roman catholics in Cob Neck aforefaid, to be appointed and elected in the manner herein after mentioned.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That all and every of the members of the faid congregation, holding Members to a pew in the church, and paying for the same, or otherwise contributing towards the support of the meet, &c. same church, or the pastor of the congregation, shall meet at their usual place of worthip on Monday after Whitfunday, in the year eighteen hundred, and on the Monday after Whitfunday in every year thereafter for ever, of which notice shall be given in the said church at the close of divine worthip on the morning of the preceding Sunday, and then and there shall elect, by ballot, the said five lay truffces, and the perions to choien shall be truffees of the faid corporation until the next election, whose names on fuch election shall be declared by the pastor, and entered in the books of the faid corporation for that purpole to be kept.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That it shall and may be lawful for the trustees above named, and Trustees may their fuccessors, from time to time as occasion shall require, to meet together for the purpose of meet, &c. transacting the business of the congregation under their care, of the time and place of which meetings due notice shall be given to all the said trustees at least two days before, and of which the pastor shall be president, if attending, and if sour of the said trustees shall attend, they shall form a quorum or board, and shall have power, by a majority of voices, to make, ordain and establish, such rules, orders and regulations, for the management of the temporal bufiness, and disposing of the estate of the faid corporation, as they shall judge proper; provided, that such rules, orders and regulations, be not repugnant to the conflitution and laws of this state.

. V. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the pastor, or any member of the faid corporation, shall have full Pastor, &c. may power and authority to adjourn from day to day until a quorum shall attend; and the faid corporati- adjourn, &c. on are hereby authorifed and empowered to appoint and employ a fit and proper person as register of the faid corporation, whose duty it shall be to keep a fair and regular account of their proceedings, which shall be subject to the inspection of any of the members belonging to the said congregation.
