succeeding flated meetings of the board of trustees, the surviving or remaining trustees, or a majorrity of them, shall, with all convenient speed, proceed to elect, by ballot, other fensible and discreet CHAP. person or persons of the said county be the truttee or trustees to supply the vacancy or vacancies LVI. occasioned by the respective causes acoresaid; and in such manner shall all suture vacancies be supplied by the faid trustees, and their successors, or a majority of them, so as to perpetuate the number of twelve persons as trustees of the faid academy for ever.

Trustees may fue, &c.

V. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid truffees, and their fuccessors, by the name and flyle aforefaid, shall be capable in law to the and be fued, plead and be impleaded, in any court or courts, and before any judge, justice or justices, within this state and effewhere, in all and all manner of faits, complaints, pleas, causes, matters and demands, of whatsoever kind, nature or form they be, and all and every other matter or thing to do thereir, in as full and effectual a manner as any other person or persons, bodies politic or corporate, within this state, or any other of the United States, in like cases may or can do or perform; and the said trustees, and their successors, or a majority of them, shall have full power and authority to have, make and wie, one common feal, with fuch devices and infcriptions as they shall think proper, and therewith to pass and authenticate the certificates, acts and orders, of the faid corporation, and the fame feal, at their pleafure, to break, after and

Appoint profellers, &c.

VI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid trustees, and their successors, or a majority of them, from time to time, and at all times hereafter, finall have full power and authority to constitute and appoint, in fuch manner as they thall think best and most convenient, professors, teachers and assistants, for instructing the students and scholars of the said academy in the vernacular and learned languages, and fuch sciences and branches of education as they shall think proper and suitable to be taught therein, and to make fundamental ordinances or regulations for the good government of the faid academy, and the instruction of the youth as aforesaid, and by these ordinances to appoint such a number of their own body, not less than feven, as they may think proper, to be a quorum or committee for transacting all general and necessary butiness of the said feminary, and making temporary rules for the management thereof, and also by the said ordinances to delegate to the professors and teachers fuch powers and authorities as they mall think expedient for the standing government and discipline of the faid feminary, and the execution of the regulations of the fame, and also by the faid ordinances to make such regulations for the direction, visitation and examination, of the said seminary, and the students and scholars therein, as shall best promote the important objects of the institution; provided always, that the faid ordinances be not repugnant to the constitution and the laws of this

Meet four times a year,

VII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid trustees, and their successors, or a majority of them, shall meet at least four times in every year, in stated quarterly meetings, to be appointed by their own ordinances, and at fuch other times as by their faid ordinances, or by their own adjournments, they may direct, and when so assembled they shall have power from time to time to appoint a president, treasurer and secretary, to make contracts with the profesiors or teachers relative to the in-Aruction of the scholars to be placed under their care, and for the payment of their salaries, to examine the progress of the students and scholars in their learning, to hear and determine on all complaints and appeals, and upon all matters touching the discipline and government of the said academy, and the wholesome execution of their ordinances, and generally to manage the estate and concerns of the faid seminary in like manner as is usually done for the advancement and advantage of similar institutions.

And qualify,

VIII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That before any trustee herein before appointed, or hereaster to be elected, shall proceed to execute the trusts and authorities delegated by this act, he shall quality himself before some magistrate, by taking an oath, or assimation, as the case may be, that he will truly and faithfully execute and perform the duties of a trustee of the said academy, without partiality or prejudice, according to the best of his skill and judgment, and agreeably to the directions of this act; and a certificate of fuch qualification shall be delivered by the magistrate, and be affiled among their proceedings.

Donation to be paid annually,

IX. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid donation shall be annually paid by the treasurer of the western shore for the time being to the order of the said trustees, and their successors, or a majority of them, which order shall be manifested by the signature of the president, and the seal of the said corporation.
