CHAP. LVL

C H A P.

An ACT to authorise the laying out a public road from Thomas Jan. 18 30. Under Hill's mill, to intersect the road leading from John Neale's to John Coxe's, in Harford county.

WHEREAS a public road leading from Thomas Under Hill's mill, to interfect the road leading from John Neale's to John Goxe's, will be a great public convenience, and is effentially. necessary; therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That John Clendenny, Nathaniel West, Commissioners Thomas Butler, William Whiteford and Thomas Montgomery, be and they are hereby appointed appointed commissioners to lay out a public road, beginning at Thomas Under Hill's mill, and to run in a direction to as to interfect a public road leading from John Neale's to John Coxe's, between Henry Richardson's and Amos Jones's; in laying out the faid road the faid commissioners are directed to take into view as well the difadvantages which may refult to individuals over whose land the faid road may run, as the convenience of the public, fo as to lay out the faid road with as little injury to private property as will comport with the public convenience.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid commissioners are hereby further directed, to return a A plot to be plot of faid road, fo by them laid out, to the clerk's office of faid county, to be there recorded; and returned, we, the levy court shall, after the return of faid plot as aforefaid, appoint a supervisor or supervisors to open the fame, and shall levy a sum of money, not exceeding one hundred dollars, for that purpose; and the faid road, when opened as aforefaid, shall be taken for, and it is hereby declared to be, a public road in faid county, and may be repaired as other public roads are repaired in faid county; provided nevertheless, that nothing herein contained shall authorise the faid commissioners to open the faid road, or the levy court to levy any fum of money for that purpose, until the affent of every person through whose land the said road may pass be first had and obtained, under the hand of every fuch person, and returned to the levy court aforefaid; and provided also, that nothing herein contained shall in any manner authorise the said commissioners to lay out the said road through the lands of any infant, or perfon non compos mentis.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the commissioners appointed in virtue of this act shall be entitled Commissioners to an allowance of two dollars for every day they finall feverally attend in discharge of the duties allowance. herein imposed.

An ACT to provide for the administration of justice in cases of Jam. 1800. crimes and misdemeanors in the city and county of Baltimore.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the governor, with the advice and confue a commission of the council, be authorifed and requested to iffue a commission of oyer and terminer and gaol on, &c. delivery for the trial of all felonies and other crimes, offences and mildemeanors, at any time heretofore committed, or that hereafter may be committed, during the continuance of this act, in Baltimore county and city, and not particularly by law directed to be tried in the general court, to one perfen of integrity, experience, and found legal knowledge, who shall be styled in the commission Chick Justice of the Court of Oyer and Terminer and Gaol Delivery for Baltimore County, and to two other persons of integrity, experience and knowledge, who shall be styled in the commission Associate Justices of the said court; and the said chief justice and associate justices shall hold their commission during good behaviour, and may be removed for milbehaviour in the fame manner as the chancellor or the judges of the general court may be removed agreeably to the constitution of this state, and not otherwife; and after issuing such commission, all crimes, offences and misdemeanors, committed, or that may hereafter be committed, during the continuance of this act, in Baltimere county or
