C H A P. LIX. Commissioners appointed, &c.

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That Richard Johns, Henry Branwell and Thomas Gorsage, or any two of them, thail be and are hereby appointed commissioners, to examine, furvey, lay out and mark, a public road from Rifter's-town aforefaid towards Hanover-town to the line of Baltimore county, of the width of fixty-fix feet, and on as streight a line as the nature of the country will permit; and the faid committioners are to confider not only the distance, but the fituation and goodness of the ground on which the said road is to pass.

Commissioners

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That Mofes Brown, Beale Owings, of Richard, and James Hood, or appointed, &c. any two of them, shall be and are hereby appointed commissioners, to examine, survey, lay out and mark, a public road from the city of Baltimore, in a direction towards Liberty-town, to the Frederick county line at or near Philemon Barn's plantation, of the width of fixty-fix feet, and on as streight a line as the nature of the country will permit, agreeably to the calls in the original law that directs the laying out faid road; and the faid commissioners are to consider not only the distance, but the situation and goodness of the ground on which the said road is to pais.

Plots to be resurned, &c.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the commissioners appointed to examine, survey and lay out, the roads aforefaid, after they shall lay out and mark the same, are hereby directed to return the courses and plots thereof to the faid commissioners of review, who are hereby authorised and required to view and examine the faid roads, and thereafter to confirm, correct or alter, the fame; and the faid commissioners of review shall cause to be made out three fair plots and certificates of the faid roads, containing the courses thereof, and such other description thereof as they may think necessary, and they shall sign their names to each plot and certificate, and return one plot and certificate to the clerk of Baltimore county, and another to the register of the city, of Baltimore, to be by them respectively recorded, and the third to be retained by the said commissioners of review; and the faid roads to laid out and confirmed, or corrected and returned as aforefaid, shall be for ever afterwards held and adjudged in all courts of law or equity public roads and common highways.

Roads, if not reviewed, to be public, &c.

V. AND BE IT ENACTED, That in case the faid commissioners of review shall not view and examine the faid roads, and confirm, or correct and alter the fame, so as finally to ascertain and fix the location of the faid roads within fix months from the return of the courses and plots thereof, then the roads fo surveyed and laid out by the commissioners appointed by this act shall be taken, held and adjudged, in all courts of law and equity, public roads and common highways, and shall as such be recorded, made, amended and repaired, in the same manner as if the said commissioners of review had approved and confirmed the same,

How vacancies are to be filled.

VI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That in case of the death, resignation, disqualification or resulal to act, of any of the commissioners aforesaid, the commissioners of review are hereby authorised and empowered to make other appointments to fill up fuch vacancy or vacancies, and re-appointments, if necessary, from time to time, as often as occasion shall require, until each of the faid roads shall be furveyed, plotted, returned and recorded, as aforefaid.

Allowance to be made, &c.

VII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the commissioners of review are hereby authorised and empowered to allow fuch reasonable compensation, not exceeding two dollars per day, to the said commissioners, and all others who may be employed in executing and carrying into effect the directions of this act, except the surveyor, to whom the said commissioners may, in their discretion, allow a compensation not exceeding four dollars per day.

Not to change former acls,

-VIII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That nothing in this act contained shall change, alter or repeal, any part of the act, entitled, An act to lay out leveral turnpike roads in Baltimore county, or one other act, entitled, An act to streighten and amend the feveral public roads in the feveral counties, and for other purposes therein mentioned, except the provision confirming the surveys and plots returned by the commissioners hereby appointed, in case the commissioners of review shall neglect to view, examine, and confirm or correct, and alter the same, and finally ascertain and fix the location thereof, within the time therein mentioned.

IX. AND, whereas it appears from the plot of the turnpike road leading from the city of Baltimore towards York-town, in the state of Pennsylvania, recorded in the clerk's office of Baltimore county, that there are two courses with calls, without expressing distances; wherefore, BE IT ENACTED, That the commissioners of review shall, on or before the first Monday in April next, appoint a surveyor to furvey the faid road, and afcertain the diffances of the courfes in all cafes where no diffances are
