

C H A P. LXXXVI.

An additional supplement to an act, entitled, An act for the relief of
 fundry insolvent debtors.

Passed 19th of
 Dec. 1800.

WHEREAS Edward Hargadine, of Queen-Anne's county, and George Carnaghan, of the city
 of Baltimore, by their petitions to this general assembly have set forth, by reason of
 many misfortunes they are unable wholly to satisfy their creditors, and have prayed for the benefit
 of an act of insolvency, upon their delivering up all their property for the use of their creditors ;
 therefore,

Preamble.

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the several provisions of the act
 passed this present session, entitled, An act for the relief of fundry insolvent debtors, shall be and
 hereby are extended to the said persons, in as full and ample manner as if their names had been
 inserted in the said act, any thing to the contrary notwithstanding.

C H A P. LXXXVII.

An ACT to revive and continue the acts of assembly therein menti-
 oned.

Passed 19th of
 Dec. 1800.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That an act, entitled, An act to make a
 temporary allowance to the judges of the general court, in addition to their permanent salaries,
 passed at November session, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-seven, shall be and the same is
 hereby continued until the thirtieth day of October, eighteen hundred and five, and to the end of
 the next session of assembly which shall happen thereafter ; that an act, entitled, A supplement to
 the act respecting certificates of surveys made on the eastern shore, passed at November session, se-
 venteen hundred and ninety-seven, shall be and is hereby continued until the thirtieth day of Octo-
 ber, eighteen hundred and one, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen
 thereafter ; that an act, entitled, An act to alter the mode of collecting the county tax in Cecil
 county, passed November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-seven, be and the same is hereby
 continued until the thirtieth day of October, eighteen hundred and five, and to the end of the next
 session of assembly that shall happen thereafter ; that an act, entitled, An act to ascertain the allow-
 ance to jurymen and witnesses of the general court, and the several county and orphans courts in
 this state, passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-seven, shall be and is hereby
 continued until the thirtieth day of October, eighteen hundred and five, and to the end of the next
 session of assembly which shall happen thereafter ; that an act, entitled, An act to enable the corpo-
 ration of the city of Annapolis to lay a tax on property within the said city and the precincts there-
 of, passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-seven, shall be and is hereby continued
 until the thirtieth day of October, eighteen hundred and five, and to the end of the next session of
 assembly which shall happen thereafter ; that an act, entitled, An act relating to the records in the
 register of wills and clerk's offices in Queen-Anne's county, passed at November session, seventeen
 hundred and ninety-seven, shall be and the same is hereby continued until the thirtieth day of Oc-
 tober, eighteen hundred and five, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen
 thereafter ; that an act, entitled, A supplement to an act, entitled, An act to ascertain the allow-
 ance of jurymen and witnesses of the general, and the several county and orphans courts in this state,
 passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-eight, shall be and is hereby continued
 until the thirtieth day of October, eighteen hundred and five, and to the end of the next session of
 assembly which shall happen thereafter ; that an act, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled,
 An act for establishing and securing the salary of the chancellor, passed November session, seventeen
 hundred and ninety-eight, shall be and is hereby continued until the thirtieth day of October,
 eighteen hundred and five, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen there-
 after ; that an act, entitled, An act to encourage the destruction of wolves and crows in the several
 counties therein mentioned, passed November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-seven, shall be
 and is hereby revived and continued until the thirtieth day of October, eighteen hundred and five,
 and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen thereafter ; provided nevertheless,
 that the several acts and supplements thereto herein mentioned shall be and are hereby declared sub-
 ject to any alterations which may have been made therein since the passage of the said laws or sup-
 plements.
