CHAPTER 36.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Benefit of in-Maryland, That the judges, or any one judge of Bal-solvent acts timore county court be, and they, or any one of them granted. are hereby authorised and directed to extend to Abraham Fuller, the benefit and relief of the act of assembly, passed at November session eighteen hundred and five, entitled, "An act for the relief of sundry insolvent debtors," and the supplements thereto, without compelling him to produce the assent of two thirds in amount, of his creditors, and to extend and afford to the said Abraham Fuller, all the benefits, advantages and provisions of the aforesaid agt and the supplements thereto, in the same manner, and upon the same terms and conditions, as if he had obtained the assent of two thirds of his creditors, to his release under the same.
