BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Extending the Maryland, That the judges, or any one judge of Prince benefits of insort George's county court, in the recess of the said court, vent laws. be, and they, or any one of them is hereby authorised and directed to extend to George Page, the benefit and relief of the act of assembly passed at Novem-ber session eighteen hundred and five, entitled, "An act for the relief of sundry insolvent debtors," and the supplements thereto, without compelling him to give the full notice to his creditors required by law in similar cases; and to extend and afford to the said George Page, all the benefits, advantages and provisions of the said act and the supplements thereto, in the same manner and upon the same terms and conditions, as if the said George Page had given the full notice to his creditors as aforesaid.
