ART. 8th. Every extra-battalion court-martial shall Extra-battalion consist of six commissioned officers.

ART. 9th. Every company court-martial shall be Company composed of one subaltern officer, one non commis-courts-martial. sioned officer and one private, to be appointed by the commanding officer of the company, and in case there should be no subaltern or non-commissioned officer attached to said company, then the captain shall apply to the commanding officer of the battalion, regiment or extra battalion to which he may be attached; who shall, within ten days after such application, order a commissioned or non-commissioned officer, or both, as the case may require, of a neighbouring company, to repair to a convenient place, designated by the captain in whose district the delinquent resides, who shall then and there hold a court-martial in the same manner as if they were attached to said company.
