state of Maryland with good and sufficient security, to be approved of by the orphans' court of Cecil county, and in such penalty as the said court shall adjudge proper, conditioned for the payment to all the heirs at law aforesaid, as they shall severally arrive at lawful age, of such part or portion of the money, with interest thereon arising from the sale of the aforesaid one undivided half part or moiety of a ware-house and wharf, situated as aforesaid, as may by law be due and payable to them; which bond shall be recorded in the office of the register of wills for the county aforesaid; upon an attested copy of which, under the seal of office, any suit or suits may be brought for the nonperformance of the condition of said bond, by any person or persons interested in the same.
