Maryland, That in a certain case now pending in the Chancery court between Peter Abrams, Harman Kerr and wife, Joseph Harland and wife, Nathan deeree a sale Blake and wife, and Thomas Protsman and wife, complainants; and Samuel Jones and wife, David, William, Rebecca and Rachel Alexander, James Alexander and wife, Joseph Reynolds and wife, Edward Alexander, Jacob Benfitt and wife, and James Donohoe and wife, defendants, the chancellor be, and he is hereby authorised and empowered, upon the hearing of the said case, and the bill now filed, and other proceedings therein had, and any future depositions which may be properly, legally and duly taken and made a part of the said case, to decree a sale of the land mentioned in the bill, and to divide the proceeds of such sale among the parties entitled to receive it, in their just proportions, according to the practice and method used in decrees for the sale of land; Provided, Proviso. It may be made appear to him that the said land cannot be divided to the benefit and advantage of all the parties concerned.

CHAPTER 198.

An act for the relief of Upton Ross, of Calvert Passed Jan. 7, 1812. county.
