Passed Dec. An act to change the name of Creswell's Ferry, in 5, 1812. Cecil county.

l'reamble.

WHEREAS, It is represented to this General Assembly, that inconveniences arise from the different names that have been applied to Creswell's ferry, on

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the place now called Creswell's ferry, in Cecil county, be and is hereby declared to be called and known in fature as Port Deposit.

CHAPTER 45.

Passed Dec. An act authorising Matthias Dashiell, late sheriff of 5, 1812. Somerset county, to complete his collections.

Collection ex-1, 1814.

Sec. 1. BEIT ENACTED by the General Astended to Jan. sembly of Maryland, That Matthias Dashiell be, and he is hereby authorised and empowered to collect until the first day of January, eighteen hundred and fourteen, all balances due him as sheriff and collector of Somerset county, in the same manner as he could or might have done within the time limited by law, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

His duty betore he proceeds to execute property or fees

AND BE IT ENACTED, That it shall be the duty of the said Matthias Dashiell, before he proceeds to execute the property of any person or persons for for public dues public dues or fees. in virtue of this act, to deliver to such person or persons chargeable with the same, at least thirty days previous to levying such execution. an account written in words at full length, of the publie dues and fees demanded of him, her or them, with an affidavit annexed, that he hath not received any
