shall place the money raised by such lottery or lotteries in the hands of the treasurer of the Baltimore and Frederick Town turnpike road company, to be applied by the said company to the paving of the said road from Frederick-town to Harper's Ferry: Provided, The said company will advance all other Proviso. necessary sums to complete the said road agreeably to an act of Assembly passed in the year of our lord eighteen hundred and nine, entitled, "A supplement to an act entitled, An act to incorporate companies to make several turnpike roads through Baltimore county, and for other purposes," giving to the company the privilege to turnpike the said road; that then, and in that case the said Baltimore and Frederick Town turnpike road company, shall be entitled to all the privileges, emoluments, and advantages given to them by the above recited act of assembly.
