An act authorising Levin Dirickson, lute sheriff und Passed Dec. collector of Worcester county, to complete his col- 14, 1812 lection.

WHEREAS, It is represented to this General Preamble. Assembly, that Levin Dirickson, late sheriff and collector of Worcester county, from various causes, has not been able to complete his collection within the limited time, and that there are still due to him as sheriff and collector of said county considerable sums of money, and praying that a law may pass to enable him to collect the same: Therefore,

SEC. 1. BEIT ENACTED by the General Assembly Collection of Maryland, That the said Levin Dirickson be, and extended to he is hereby authorised to collect, until the first day of Jan. 1, 1814 January eighteen hundred and fourteen, all balances due him as sheriff and collector of Worcester county,

for the year eighteen hundred and twelve, in the same manner as he could or might have done within the time limited by law, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

2. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the said Levin Dirickson, before he derives any benefit from or un lection books der this act, shall lodge his collection books, or a construction books, in the clerk's office of Worcester county, clerk's office.
