CHAPTER 129. ♥

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Act of the Maryland, That an act entitled, "An act to alter confirmed the time of the meeting of the General Assembly of this State and for other purposes," be, and it is hereby confirmed and made valid to every intent and purpose therein mentioned.

CHAPTER 130.

An act annulling the marriage of Jerome Bonaparte, Passed and Elizabeth Bonaparte of the city of Balti- 15, 1812. Passed Dec. more.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the marriage of the said Jerome Bonaparte, and Elizabeth Bonaparte of the city of Baltimore, heretofore solemnized, be, and the same is hereby declared to be absolutely, to all intents and purposes null and void; and the said Jerome Bonaparte and Elizabeth Bonaparte, are declared to be divorced, a vinculo matrimonii: Provided neverthe- Previso. less, That nothing in this act contained shall be construed to illegitimate the child born of the said Jerome and Elizabeth Bonaparte, any law to the contrary not withstanding.

CHAPTER 131.

An act authorising Thomas Saulsbury, late sheriff Passed Dec. and collector of Caroline county, to complete his 16, 1812. collectin.

SEC. 1. BE IT ENACTED by the General As sembly of Maryland, That the said Thomas Sauls. extended to bury be, and he is hereby authorised and empowered Jan. 1, 1814. to collect until the first day of January eighteen hundred and fourteen, all balances due him as sheriff and collector of Caroline county, in the same manner as he could or might have done within the time limited by law, any law to the contrary notwithstanding. 2. AND BE IT ENACTED, That it shall be

the duty of the said Thomas Saulsbury, before he execution. proceeds to execute or distrain the property of any person or persons for public dues in virtue this act, to deliver to such person or persons changable
