Passed Dec. An act to alter the time of holding Baltimore county 24, 1812.

Court to be lield on the third Monday in September.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That hereafter, Baltimore county court shall commence and hold its session on the third Monday of September in each and every year, instead of the first Tuesday of October.

CHAPTER 133.

Passed Dec. An act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike 19, 1812. road from Elkton to Christiana Bridge.

Company incorporated. SEC. 1. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a company be incorporated to make a turnpike road from the landing at the confluence of Big and Little Elk Creeks in Cecil county, to Christiana Bridge in the State of Delaware.
