CHAPTER 157.

An act to alter and change the place of holding the elections in the first election district of Kent county.

Passed Jan 31, 1814.

Section 1. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the judges of the first election district of Kent county be, and are hereby authorized and directed to hold in future the elections in said district at such place as may appear to them most convenient.

Judges to appoint the place of election.

2. AND BE IT ENACTED, That where the judges aforesaid shall have made choice of a fit and proper place for holding said election, agreeably to the directions of this act; and shall have returned a certificate thereof under their hands and seals, to the clerk of the county court, to be recorded, the same shall be the place of holding the elections for the first district of Kent county, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

Return and record.

3. AND BE IT ENACTED, That a return of said certificate shall be made on or before the first day of June next, and the clerk aforesaid shall record the same among the records of Kent county.

Before the 1st June next.

CHAPTER 158.

A supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the stock-holders of the Hager's-Town Bank.

Passed Jan. 31, 1814.

WHEREAS, the charter of the Hager's-Town Bank provides, that one director for said bank shall be elected in the city of Baltimore, and one in the county of Allegany: Therefore,

Preamble

Section 1. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That after the passage of this act, the stock-holders of the said bank shall not be compelled to elect any director residing out of the county of Washington; Provided nevertheless, That the board shall consist of the same number of directors as were heretofore elected for said bank.
