SEC. 1. BE IT ENACTED by the general assembly of ed in him. Maryland, That the title to the real property of the said Charles Rice, fully and fairly acquired heretofore, by purchase or deed, be and the same is hereby amply and fully vested in the said Charles Rice, and his heirs, in fee simple to all intents and purposes, in the same manner that it would have been, if the said Charles Rice, had been duly naturalized, agreeably to the said laws, at the time of the said purchase, and when he received his said deed; Provided always, That nothing in this act contained, Provise. shall in any manner defeat or affect any right, title or claim to the said property, or any part thereof, acquired or prosecuted by any person or persons whatever, before the passage of this act; and provided also, That the said Charles Rice, shall within twelve months after he is capable of becoming a citizen, naturalize himself agreeably to the laws of the United States; but if the said Charles Rice should die before he becomes naturalized, nothing in this proviso shall prevent him from transmitting or transferring his said property, by descent or devise, to any person or persons, being a citizen or citizens of the Unised States, and residing therein, capable in law to held the
