Sess. sessable property in Harford county, and cause the same to be collected as are other taxes; and when at any time said company shall levy a toll on any part of the said roads herein directed to be laid out in Harford county, said company shall reimburse all such damages and expences on opening such part of the roads as shall have been incurred by said county, which shall be paid in stock of said company, and the levy court shall have power to subscribe for the same, and all damages which shall be adjudged to proprietors of ground in Baltimore county

11. AND BE IT ENACTED, That said company shall have power if in their opinion any improvement can be made ments in local in the location of said road or roads, which they shall deter- tion-plot. mine to make turnpike roads, either by straightening the same or placing the road on more favorable ground, to alter or change the location of the same; Provided, that one branch shall pass through Belle-Air, and the place where said roads branch or separate as aforesaid shall remain the same; and if any person over whose ground the road shall pass, where such alteration in the location will be made, shall claim damages arising from such change in the location, and the parties cannot agree, the judges of the county court of the county in which such road shall lie, shall appoint five persons who shall estimate the damages if any there be, which such person shall sustain by altering the location, and the said company shall pay the amount to the person entitled thereto; and said company shall cause a plot of the road as so altered, to be made out and filed in the office of the county courts of said counties; and said company shall cause mile stones to be put up on such part of the said road as they shall subject to toll.

12. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the president and managers of said company, may in their discretion increase be increased. the tolls beyond the rates herein prescribed, such not exceeding thirty three and a third per cent, during the months of December, January, February and March; Provided, that for the rest of the year, the tolls be so much lowered that on making an average of the rates and time, such average shall not exceed

the rates prescribed as aforesaid.

13. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the justices of the levy courts of Baltimore and Flatford counties respectively, be closed. shall have power to discontinue and shut up any public road which they shall deem to be rendered unnecessary by reason of opening said road or roads, if the same shall be desired by the party through whose land the old road does pass, and whenever by the departure of the new road from the bed of the old road it may be necessary to extend any road which at present leads into and intersects the old road; it shall be lawful for the justices of the levy courts aforesaid to extend such road until it intersects the new road in such direction as said justices shall deem most conducive to public utility.

14. AND BE IT ENACTED, That said first named commissioners shall receive two dollars per day for every day they tion. shall be employed in executing the duties imposed by this act, which with all other charges which shall be incurred in laying
