And be it enacted, That all the meetings of the trustees of Meetings of the poor necessary to be held for the purpose of carrying into ef- trustees. fect the provisions of this act, or of the original act, or of the supplement thereto, shall be held at the alms-house in the said county, except such meetings as may be necessary for the settle-

ment and passing their accounts with the levy court.

9. And be it enacted, That the clerk of said court shall be al- Allowance to lowed twenty-five cents for each certificate of appointment which clerk for each he shall make out and deliver to the sheriff; and the sheriff shall certificate be allowed fifty cents for the delivery of each of the said certificates to the persons appointed, all of which charges and allowances are to be levied, collected and paid over, as other county charges are.

10. And be it enacted, That any thing in the said original act, Repeal. or the supplement thereto, which is repugnant to or inconsistent with the provisions of this act, shall be and the same is hereby

repealed.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, A company in-That a company be incorporated for making a turppike road, be- corporated. ginning at the termination of the Baltimore and Frederick turnpike road, and running thence in the nearest and most practicable route through the town of William's-Port, to the Conoco-

cheague creek. 2. And be it enacted, That subscription books be opened for a Subscription capital stock of seventy thousand dollars, in shares of twenty books to be dollars, to be taken in for twenty thousand dollars of the same opened. at Baltimore, under the direction of John E. Howard, William Cooke, senior, Robert Smith, Roswell S. Colt, Robert Gilmor, junior, Thomas Ellicott, Isaac Tyson, James Cheston, Jeremiah Sullivan and Henry Lee Williams, or any two of them; and for thirty thousand dollars at William's Port, under the direction of Thomas Buchanan, Frisby Tilghman, Edmund H. Turner. Daniel Rentch, or any two of them; and for ten thousand dollars at Frederick-town, under the direction of Abraham Shriver, George, Baer and Michael Hauser, or any two of them; and for tenthousand dollars at Cumberland, in Allegany county, under the direction of William M. Mahon, Thomas J. Perry and Benjamin Tomlinson, or any of them; who are hereby appointed commissioners for the purposes herein mentioned.

3. And be it enacted, That when lifteen hundred shares of said Subscribers to stock shall have been subscribed for, the commissioners shall meet and orgive twenty days public notice thereof, in one of the news-papers ny. printed in Hager's-town, one in Cumberland, one in Frederick-
