and return the same to the clerk of Cacil county court, to be Dec. Ses. 1816 recorded; and the said commissioners, before they proceed to act, shall take the following oath, or affirmation: "I, A. B. do swear, (or affirm) that I will lay out and mark the Conowingo turnpike road according to the best of my skill and judgment, and according to the directions of an act of assembly, entitled, An act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from the contemplated bridge over the river Susquehanna, at Conowingo creek, to the Pennsylvania line; and I do further swear, (or affirm,) that I am not interested in any land through which

said road is likely to pass."

7. And be it enacted, That the said company shall open said — to be sixty feet wide. road from the site of the Conowingo Bridge, in Cacil county aforesaid, to the Pennsylvania line, to intersect a turnpike to be made from Philadelphia via New-London Cross Roads to the said line, according to the location of the commissioners aforcsaid, sixty feet wide, of which at least twenty feet shall be artificial road, composed of stone, gravel, or other hard substance; Provided, that no tolls shall be demanded or taken from Proviso. any person passing or repassing from one part of his farm to another, or to or from any place of public worship or functal, on any days appointed for that purpose, or from militia-men on days of training, or from voters on days of election, attending the polls, going to, or returning from the same,

8. And be it enacted, That said company shall be and are here- Privileges of by invested and clothed with all the privileges, rights, immuni-company. ties and advantages, which are held and possessed by the turnpike company incorporated by an act passed at November session eighteen hundred and twelve, entitled, An act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from the district of Columbia to the city of Baltimore, to be governed by the same regulations as are therein prescribed, and be entitled to the same tolls, and every clause and provision of said act relative to the road therein proposed to be made, shall be in force as relates to the road herein contemplated, so far as the same are applicable and

not inconsistent with this act.

9. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for any corporati- Corporations on or body politic in the United States to become stockholders in may become the said company.

10. And he it enacted, That if said company do not proceed to In case of comcarry on said work within three years after the passing of this pany's failure act, or shall not within ten years thereafter complete the said road, state to resume rights, &c. it shall be lawful for the legislature of this state to resume the rights, liberties, privileges and franchises, granted by this act to

said company.

11. And be it enacted, That the county court of Cæcil county Damages to be shall appoint five commissioners, who shall estimate the amount estimated, of damages sustained by any person or persons by reason of said road passing through his, her, or their land, or by taking stone, gravel or earth, or other materials, for the use of said road, in cases where the parties cannot agree, which estimate shall be final in determining such damages.
