CHAPTER 107.

An act for the relief of John Frey, of Cecil county. Scc. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Judges authorised to extend to him the judges of Cecil county court be and they are hereby authorised, the benefit of insolvent laws, &c. to extend to John Frey, of Cecil county, the benefit of the existing insolvent laws of the state, without requiring the assent in writing of two thirds of his creditors in amount.

CHAPTER 108.

An act for the relief of the Eldest Daughter of Eleanor Passed Feb 3 1919] Nicholes, of Montgomery county.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, 'That Levy authorised the levy court of Montgomery county be, and they are hereby authorised, to levy on the assessable property of said county, annually, as long as they may deem proper, a sum of money not exceeding thirty dollars, for the support and maintenance of the eldest daughter of said Eleanor Nicholes, and that the same shall be collected by the collector of said county, and by him paid to Eleanor Nicholes, or her order, for the use and benefit of her said eldest daughter.

CHAPTER 109.

An act to incorporate the Trustees of Big Pipe Creek-Aca-Passed Fob 2 1819 demy in Frederick county.

WHEREAS sundry inhabitants of Frederick county have, by their Preamble petition, set forth to the general assembly, that they have purchased a lot of ground in the vicinity of Big Pipe creek, in said county, and intend erecting thereon suitable buildings for a seminary of learning, and have prayed for an act of incorporation for the regulation of said seminary, and it appearing reasonable that the prayer of said-petitioners ought to be granted, therefore,

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Trustees appoints cland incorporation David Kephart, Jacob Yon, and William B. Hebbard, be and they rated are hereby appointed trusters of said seminary, to act as such until the first Monday of November eighteen hundred and nineteen; and the said trustees, and their successors, to be elected in the manner herein after mentioned, shall be and they are hereby erected, established and declared, to be one community, corporation and body politic, with perpetual succession, in deed and law, to all intents and purposes connected with the said institution, by the name and style of The Trustees of Big Pipe Creek Academy in Frederick county, by which name and title they the said trustees, and their successors, shall be competent, and capable in law and equity, to take and hold to themselves, and their successors, for the use of said academy, any estate in any messuages, lands and tenements, goods, chattels, money or effects, by the gift, grant, bargain, sale,
