way or manner whatever, be and the same is hereby annulled and CHAP. 1446 made void; and that the said Mary Louisa Hall be and she is hereby declared capable to have, hold, take, receive, sue for and recover, by compromise, suit or suits in law or equity, all such property, in as full and ample a manner as it she were a feme sole, and had never been married, and to hold, use, and enjoy the same, for her own use and benefit, and the same to dispose of according to ber will and pleasure, without the molestation, interference, hinderance or consent, of her said husband, in the same manner she could or might have done were she a feme sole.

CHAPTER 145.

An act for the relief of Stephen Lewis, of Worcester Pauced Feb 6 1819 county.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Dirorce granted. Stophen Lewis, of Worcester county, he and he is hereby divorced from bed, board and mutual conabitation, with his wife Betsey Lewis.

2. And be it enacted, That all rights or interests which may have Certain rights and heretofore accrued, or would hereafter accrue, either to the said &c. Stephen Lewis, or to the said Betsey Lowis, and all obligations and liabilities heretofore between the said parties created, or which could be created by virtue of their marriage, be and the same are hereby abrogated, made null and void.

CHAPTER 146.

A Supplement to an act authorising the Levy Court of Passed Feb 9 1819; Somerset County to levy and assess a sum of money for certain purposes therein mentioned.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Certain money the levy court of Somerset county, he and they are hereby authorised and required, to appropriate the money levied in the year penses of county eighteen hundred and eighteen, under the authority of the law to for present year, which this is a supplement, to the payment of the expenses of the said county for the present year.

2. And be it enacted, That the act authorising the levy court of Act repealed, Somerset county, to levy and assess a sum of money for the pur-

poses therein mentioned, be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 147.

An act declaring the continuation and extension of the Char-Paued Feb. 9, 1870 ter of the Elkton Bank of Maryland.

WHEREAS by an act of the general assembly of Maryland, pas- Preamble. sed at December session one thousand eight hundred and thirteen, chapter one hundred and twenty-two, entitled, "A supplement to, the act, entitled, An act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road leading to Cumberland, and for the extension of the charters of the several banks in the city of Baltimore, and for other purposes," certain conditions are mentioned and specified, by a compliance with which said conditions the charters of the soveral banks in this state, so complying with the said conditions, were to be extended and renewed, for a certain time therein limited and Expressed: And whereas, not withstanding the Elkton Bank of Ma-
