CHAPTER 176.

A Supplement to the act, entitled, An act for incorporating Paued Feb 151 a Company for erecting a Bridge over Nanticoke River at or near Vienna in Dorchester county.

Sec. 1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Time for opening the time for procuring and opening the books of subscription for tended. shares in said company, be and the same is hereby extended to the first day of January eighteen hundred and twenty, and that Charles Venables and William Russum, of Somerset county, and Doctor Clement Stanford of Dorchester county, are hereby appointed commissioners, in addition to those appointed by the act to which this

is a supplement, to carry said law into effect.

2. And be it enacted, That from and after the passage of this Proviso in tenth act, the proviso in the tenth section of the act to which this is a sup-law repealed. plement, authorising the levy courts of Dorchester and Somerset counties to lovy and assess the sum of two hundred dollars on each of the said counties, to be paid to the president and directors of said company, be and the same is hereby repealed, and that the president and directors of said company be authorised to demand and receive from the people of said counties, the same tolls which they are authorised to demand of persons not residents of said counties.

3. And be it enacted, That in lieu of the tolls authorised by the more than a cents act to which this is a supplement, to be collected from foot passen-scuger. gers crossing said bridge, they shall not be authorised to demand or receive a greater sum than three cents from each foot passenger.

4. And be it enacted, That one-third part of the capital stock of enpiral to be resaid company be reserved for the use of the state, to be subscribed of the suce. for by the treasurer of the eastern shore, and paid out of any unappropriated money in the treasury, whenever the remaining two-thirds shall have been subscribed.

CHAPTER 177.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That note of any bank any person having a claim upon or holding a note of any bank in demanding part this state, under fifty dollars, after demand of payment of such an independent between claim or note at the bank, and refusal or neglect to pay, may re- judgment below cover judgment for the same before a justice of the peace of the peace. county, where the bank is established.

That the proceedings under the above pro- in the above case vision shall be a summons to be served by the proper officer on the president or cashier of the bank, or to be left at the banking house, during the usual banking hours; and in all other respects shall be according to the provisions of an act, entitled, An act for the specdy recovery of small debts out of court, and to repeal the acts of assembly therein mentioned, and the supplements thereto.

And be it enacted, That any bank neglecting or refusing to Bank neglecting or refusing to pay its debute pay its debts, shall pay an interest at the rate of six per centum pay an interest of per annum. to commence from the time of demand of payment of the particular debt, and neglect or refusal to pay.
