CHAP. VII.

An Act to extend the time of completing the Turnpike Road leading from Boonsborough to Swearingen's Ferry, in Washington County. Passed Dec 17

Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the further term of four years is hereby granted to the president, managers and company, of the Boonsborough Turnpike Company, to complete the turnpike road leading from Boonsborough to Swearingen's Ferry, in Washington county. Time extended for collection

CHAP. VIII.

An Act to repeal certain Acts therein mentioned.

CHAP. IX.

An Act to authorise George A. Smith, late Sheriff of Caroline County, to complete his Collections. Passed Dec 20

1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That George A. Smith, late sheriff of Caroline county, be and he is hereby authorised and empowered, to collect until the first day of January eighteen hundred and twenty-one, all balances due him as sheriff of said county, in the same manner (which he could or might have done within the time limited by law, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

Time for collection extended

2. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the said George A. Smith, before he proceeds to execute or distrain the property of any person or persons for fees or public dues, in virtue of this act, to deliver to, or leave at the last place of abode of such person or persons, his, her, or their executors or administrators, chargeable with the same, at least thirty days previous to levying such execution or distress, an account, written in words at full length, of the fees or public dues demanded of him, her or them, with an affidavit thereto annexed, if required, that he hath not received any
