Thomas, John Andrews, Arthur Andrews, James Steele, William Noble, Simeon Pownell, Timothy Kirl, of the state of Pennsylvania; and William Stansbury, Charles Carroll, Eli Balderston, Thomas Tenant, of the city of Baltimore; James Jenny, Samuel Bowland, Reverend James M. Graw, Samuel Clendenin, Thomas Richards, Jonas Preston, of Cecil county, state of Maryland; or any two of them, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to do and perform the several things hereinafter mentioned; that is to say, they shall on or before the first Monday of May Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and twenty, procure a sufficient number of books, one or more of which shall be opened at some convenient place in each of the following places, viz: In the City of Lancaster, Borough of Strasburgh, Andrew's tavern, John Hill's tayern, in the City of Lancaster, at George Phillip's tayern, David Thomas's tavern, in Chester county, all in the state of Pennsylvania; in the City, of Baltimore, Port Deposit, and Nathaniel Ewing's tavern, at Bald Fryer Ferry, in the state of Maryland; and in each of them enter as follows, or to the following effect: "We whose names are hereunto subscribed, do promise to pay to the president and managers of the Octoraro Navigation Company, the sum of twenty-five dollars, for every share of stock set opposite to our respective names, in such manner and proportions, and at such times, as shall be determined by the president and managers of the said company, in pursuance of an act of the general assembly of Maryland, entitled, An act to incorporate the Octoraro Navigation Company.
