case of forfeiture or resumption by the legislature of the rights, CHAP. 94. liberties, privileges and franchises, hereby granted, nothing herein contained shall be construed to work a forfeiture of the rights of individuals to water power under the grants made by the president, managers and company, but the same shall be held by individuals in as full and ample a manner as they might do if no such forfeituro or resumption had taken place, and in lieu of such resumption the principal sum paid, or secured to be paid, when the conveyance has been in fee simple, and the accruing rents and profits when the said water power has been let for one or more years, shall be forfeited to the state of Maryland; And provided also, that if the said company shall at any time hereafter misuse or abuse any of the chartered privileges hereby granted, the legislature may saffany time thereafter resume all and singular the rights, privileges and franchises, hereby granted to said company.

CHAP. XCY.

A Further Supplement to an act, entitled, An act to regulate the Inspection of Paued Jan 31, 1920 Tobacco.

1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That from Inspectors to satisfy themselves in and after the first day of March eighteen hundred and twenty, it was grown &c. shall be the duty of each and every inspector of tobacco in this state, whenever tohacco shall be offered for inspection at the warehouse for which he has been appointed, before he proceeds to inspect the same, to inquire and satisfy himself in what state or territory such tobacco was grown, and if he shall have doubts respecting the origin of any tobacco so offered for inspection, he shall have power, and he is hereby authorised and required, to examine any person or persons who may offer to give evidence of the fact, on oath or affirmation, as the case may be, and upon his being satisfied thereof, and not before, he shall proceed to inspect the same, and enter on his inspection book the name of the state or territory where such tobacco was, made, and specify the same in all notes and manifests which he may issue for tobacco inspected by him; and if the tobacco be not of the growth of this state, he shall cause the name of the state or territory, wherein the same may have been grown, to be carved or branded on three staves of each cask, in the most conspicuous parts thereof.

2. And be it enacted, That if any inspector of tobacco at any Penalty for no warehouse in this state, shall neglect to comply with any, of the ply with provisions provisions contained in the aforegoing section, he shall for each and every offence forfeit and pay the sum of one hundred dollars, to be recovered by indictment in the court of the county where such offence was committed, one half to the informer and the other half to

the state.

CHAP. XCVI.

An Act to authorise John Cole, late Sheriff and Collector of Saint Mary's Coun- Passed Jan 31 1820 ty, to complete his Collection.

1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland. That the Time for collection on extended, &c. said John Cole be and he is hereby authorised to collect, until the
