CHAP. LXXXIV.

A Supplement to an act, entitled, An Act to incorporate the Roman Catholic Passed Jan 20 1421 Congregation in Baltimore Town.

WHEREAS the most Reverend Ambrose Marcschal, Archbishop Preamble of Baltimore, the Reverend James Whitfield, Rectors of said Congregation, David Williamson, Luke Tiernan, Philip Lawrence, Basil S. Elder, John Walsh, William Jenkins, and Robert Barry, the present Trustees of the said Congregation, have represented to this general assembly, by their memorial, that a change of circumstances, as set forth in their said memorial, has rendered certain alterations and modifications of their said act of incorporation necessary and proper; and it appearing reasonable that the prayer of the said memorial should be granted. Therefore.

1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That from Name of corpor henceforth the corporation or body politic now known and distinguished by the name, style and title of The Trustees of the Roman Catholic Congregation in the Town of Baltimore, shall be, and they are hereby declared to be, a corporation and body politic, by and under the name, style and title of Trustees of the Catholic Cathedral Church of Baltimore, and that the said trustees, by the name last aforcsaid, and their successors, to be elected as hereinafter mentioned and provided, shall have perpetual succession, and shall be able and capable in law to purchase, take, hold, receive and enjoy, to them and their successors, in fee simple, or for any lesser estate, any property real, personal or mixed, which by the constitution and laws of this state may be acquired and held by religious societies, not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars, exclusive of the Cathedral; and also that the said trusters, by the name aforesaid, shall be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, in any court of law or equity, in as full and effectual manner as any other person or persons, bodies politic or corporate, may sue or be sued, implead or be impleaded, answer or be answered unto; and that it shall and may be lawful for the said trustees, by the name aforesaid, to cause to be made and to use a common seal, to authenticate all acts and instruments of writing re-pecting their business and concerns, and the same at pleasure to alter and renew.
