New board of commissioners appointed for Monte COMETY

1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Upton Beall, Thomas A. Brook, William Wilson, Howard Griffith. John H. Riggs, William Wilson, of John, George B. Hays, Thomas T. Wheeler, Basil Darby, John Rabbit, and Thomas Gettings, be and they are hereby appointed and substituted as a separate independent board of commissioners of the school fund for Montgomery county, in lieu of the persons heretofore appointed; which commissioners herein named shall have and exercise all the power and authorities vested in the commissioners for Montgomery county by the act to which this is a further supplement, and they may supply all vacancies happening in their board, so that the same shall always consist of at least eleven members.

And be it enacted, That the said commissioners be and they are hereby authorised and required, to call on the treasurer of the western shore of Maryland, who is hereby authorized and required to pay over the money, and transfer the stock appropriate to said county, to the said commissioners, or their authorised agent, to be appropriated by the commissioners herein named as is directed by the act to which this is a further supplement.
