An Act for the benefit of John Mercer.

Paued Feb 16 1821 Rreamble

WHEREAS John Mercer, of Anne-Arundel county, has acquired by marriage the ownership of a female mulatto slave named Julia, residing in that part of the District of Columbia, which is on the south side of the river Potomac, and is desirous of removing her into this state; Therefore,

Authorised to re ove slave into this state

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the said John Mercer be and he hereby is authorised to remove the said temale mulatto slave into this state, at any time within one year from the passage of this act, and the removal of said slave shall not operate to entitle her to freedom; Provided, that the said slave shall be recorded in the records of Anne-Arundel county within three months after her being removed as aforesaid into this state, and nothing in this act shall be construed to authorise

the said John Mercer to make sale of said slave within three

years after her removal.
