And be it enacted, That for the purpose of enabling the socie- Marshals. y aforesaid, to give greater efficiency to the rules and regulations of spond heir respective officers for the preservation of good order on the articular occasions of its public cattle shows and exhibitions, the sistan rustees of the said society shall be and are hereby authorised to noninate and appoint a sufficient number of suitable persons, who shall einhabitants of the county, to act as marshals who shall be sworn the faithful and impartial discharge of their duty, and shall have he same authority in relation to the preservation of the public peace nd to the service and execution of criminal process within the limits rescribed for the holding of such shows and exhibitions, as constables by law now have, and they shall exercise their said office from welve o'clock, at noon of the day preceeding the day of the commencement of said shows and exhibitions, until twelve o'clock, at noon of the day succeeding the termination thereof and no longer.

5. And be it further enacted, That who so ever from & after the passage of this act shall erect a booth or other arrangment for the purpose of selling, or shall sell or dispose of any spirituous liquor within one mile of the grounds defined and fixed for the holding of the annual cattle shows and exhibitions, as provided for in this act, without permission granted in writing, signed by the chairman of the board of trustees and countersigned by the corresponding secretary of said society, said person or persons so selling or disposing of spirituous liquors shall forfeit and pay the sum of forty dollars, to be sued for before any justice of the peace by the treasurer of said society, and paid to him for the benefit of said society; Previded, that this act shall not be construed to affect any person or persons resident within the said prescribed limits, who may be authorised to sell spirituous liquors, in any other manner than to prevent them from erecting a booth or booths or other arrangment for the purpose of selling said liqours.

CHAPTER 174.

An act to incorporate the Village of Federalsburgh, in Dorchester and Caroline Counties.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Incorporation the citizens of the Village of Federalsburgh, in Dorchester and Caroline counties, shall be, and they are hereby constituted and made a body corporate, by the name of the Commissioners of the Village of Federalsburgh, with all the privileges of a body corporate, and to have a common seal and perpetual succession.

2. And be it enacted, That the free male white citizens of the Vil- Elections. lage of Federalsburgh aforesaid, of the age of twenty-one years and upwards and have resided in the said Village of Federalsburgh for and during the space of six months next preceeding the election, shall, on the first Monday in May next, at the House now occupied as a Ta-
