

on by the Upper House & that an Act may pass as it is there prayed
W^m Bretton 

Ordered that this Petition ^{be referred} till the Bill for the Confirmation of all Alienations for Lands &c. be passed by both Houses

Ordered that the S^r Cap^t Tho: Cornwallis by himself or attorney come to this House & assign errors in Judgment by to morrow.

Then came Tho: motley from the Lower House & desired Bills might be drawn for the Consideration of both Houses viz:

An Act concerning payment of Debts

An Act for the Administration of Justice &c.

An Act concerning Attorneys &c.

An Act for the Advancement of Children's Estates

An Act for Confirmation of Tho: Taylors peti. on
