

Then was read an Act for repeal of the second Branch of the Act made at St Johns 4th March 1647 by Tho: Green Esq Govern^r continued an Act touching payment of Debts

Then was read an Act for Attorneys for Business out of England

Then was read an additional Act for Advancem^t of Children's Estates

Then was read an Act for the Administration of Justice Voted that they be sent to the Lower House to be there considered & that the Lower House is desired to take them into their Consideration with all speed possible that this House may proceed to put them to the Vote which they desire for the avoiding of unnecessary expences of time

Was returned the additional Act for the Advancement of Childrens Estates from the Lower House wherein they desired the Words Handy Craft Trade might be struck out

Ordered that answer be returned that to strike out these Words Handy Craft Trade was to destroy the very thing intended by the Act which was to breed up all the indigent youth of this Province to Handy Craft Trade & no other

Came Mr Richard Bennet with this Vote from the Lower house viz The Vote of this House is in the Act for Attorneys that not only Attorneys but that any other Persons from foreign parts pretending to an Estate here upon what Title soever shall be obliged to put in Security under the same penalty as Attorneys are

By order of the House W^m Britton Clk.

Ordered that answer be returned to the Lower House that the House doth not judge it fit to put any person that comes to seek his due in proper person into the same Condition with Attorneys because he is here to answer any thing that is lain to his Charge Whereas the Attorneys Power dies with his suit

The House is Adjourned till two of the Clock in the Afternoon
The House met again

Then was read an Act for Amerciements in the Provincial County Courts Ordered to be sent to the Lower House

Was read an Act against exportation of Wool & old Iron

Was read an Act drawn yesterday according to the Vote concerning the Secretarys Fees

Was read an Act to give Smiths Execution for their Debts

Voted that these four Acts be sent to the Lower House for their Consideration

In the upper House of Assembly at St. Marys there being then present also a Committee from the Lower House viz Thomas Motley W^m Calvert Esq Capt Tho: Stockell Capt Mica: Guyther
