Then came the high sherriff of the County of St^t Marys &
returned the Writ of Scire facias executed.

The Act for proceedings at Law Voted to pass

Then came from the Lower House an Act for a prison at
St^t Marys

Ordered that the Act be referred to a Conference with the
Lower House as also an Act for an Office to keep the Records in

Then was read an Act prohibiting the Exportation of Hides
Ordered that the Lower House be desired to strike out these
words in the Act prohibiting Exportation of Hides Viz one half
of the Fine to Francis Jackson Gent: & instead thereof to put in
the Lord Proprietor, & if they think fit to Grant any other Inco-
:ragement unto the said Francis Jackson that they are desired to
insert it.

Then was read an Act for the repeal of the first Branch
of the Act made at St^t Johns 17th April 1661 by Philip Calvert
Esq^r Govern^r Entituled an Act concerning killing wild Cattle
Ordered that these words with licence from the Lieuten^t Gen^l
be inserted in this Act

Then was read an Act for the quietting Possessions of Lands
& Establishing the manner of Conveyances of Land for the future
Ordered that after these words (Disturbance or Denyal in
the first Clause in the Act be inserted these words by any Claim
to be made after the 24th day of March which shall be in the year
of our Lord God 1664 by any person or persons whatsoever &
& that we have a Conference with the lower House about this Act
& the Reason of the Amendments.
