were Adjourned and resolved into a Committee to attend this house in  
order to the prosecution of their Charge against the said Richd.  
Tilghman.

The Lower House with their Speaker hereupon attending this  
House the petition of the Lower House & Charge against him and  
the petitions before recited being read he put in his Answer these  
unto in these words viz.

The Answer of Richard Tilghman to a certain paper of  
articles exhibited from the Lower House against the said Tilghman  
to the honourable the Upper House of Assembly as high Sheriff of  
Talbot County

The first article wherein the said Tilghman was charged for  
Loying and exacting from the people of that County more Tobacco  
than was due or accepted by the publick and his Lordship's Commt.  
of that County this Respon<sup>d</sup>t saith that the List of the publick  
and County Charge was sent by the Clerk of the County to your  
Respon<sup>d</sup>t about the twentieth of November 1670 signed under his  
hand wherein the publick charge that your Respondent was  
to pay amounted to 3212*lb*: the Salary whereof is 32*lb* in  
all 3533*lb*. This *lb*: was to be Raised out of 776 Tythables of  
our County that it was not cast up off poll as by the List under the  
Clerks hand may appear That it being late in the year & your  
Respon<sup>d</sup>t sickly he was obliged to cast it up at what poll &  
so enter it in his Book that so his Under Sheriff might go to  
receive *lb*: which he did in the presence of Mr Tho. Hulfor  
one of our Commt. & Mr John Keely That at that time it was  
cast up at 47*lb* off poll but suddenly after by your Respon<sup>d</sup>t alone  
found..... to be only 4*lb*, & about 3*lb* over which he did immedi-  
ately certify to his Under Sheriff and accordingly he did receive of  
the people That your Respon<sup>d</sup>t after this did hear of some news  
that the Countys had declared to the people that the Levy was  
4*lb* off poll That in January Court they were about Examining the
