

may not be necessary that a Law be made, that all people that live remote from the Waterside, having dealt for their Tobacco with any merchant or others be not obliged to bring it to some convenient or secure place within half a mile from the Waterside & within a week after it is received

Resolved in the Affirmative & that the Committee of this house draw up a Bill for that purpose with a proviso that the Com^{ts} of the respective Countys appoint the places where these Houses are to be built Provided there be no houses convenient already & that the upper House be desired to concur with this house in this Vote & send their answer to this House

The above Vote delivered to this House by Cap^t. Burgess & Mr. Weeks

An Answer to the last message of this house touching the Limitation of Servants times was returned from the Lower House as followeth Viz^t

Upon the return of the above said answer from the Upper house put to the Vote whether the former Law now in force limiting Servants times with Addition of Certificates from the Register Office in his Majesty's Kingdoms & Dominions to be Equivalent with Indentures be sufficient or whether a new one should be made according to the preceding Votes Resolved that the old Law be continued & the Addition a^d be added
