

being about a mile North from the Land called Daniel's Mount to be held of the manour of Saccaiah Beginning at a marked Oak upon an hill by a great Swamp near a low path called Saccaiah Path bounding on the West by a line drawn North & by West for length three hundred & twenty perches to an Oak by a Run side in a Swamp on the North by a line drawn East & by North from the said Oak for breadth five hundred perches on the East by a line drawn South and by East from the End of the East & by North line for length three hundred & twenty perches on the South by a line drawn West and by South from the End of the South & by East line unto the first marked Oak containing & now laid out for one thousand Acres more or less

Upon reading of an Act for Explanation of an Act for Secretary's Fees Resolved that the fee for the Search be but four pounds of tobacco in that year only in which the Search is made & if any search be made for ten years then for Search forty pounds of tob^o after the Rate of 4^{lb} Ann^o and for all Searches above ten years no fee above 40 tob^o To which Resolve & Vote of this House they desire the Concurrence of the Upper house
