 Balley Defendant in a Plea of Debt and it is Granted unto him the Tenor whereof
 followeth in these words Viz: Cecilus Absolute Lord and Proprietary of Maryland
 and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore 6th To the Justices of the Provincial Court of
 the said Province of Maryland Greeting Because in the Record and Proceps as also
 in the Reading of Judgment and Granting of Scire facias thereupon before you
 in our said Court against Jo: Balley at the Suit of Raymond Stapleford in a Plea
 of Debt Manifest Error hath happened to the Great Damage of the said Jo: Balley
 as by the great Complaint of the said Jo: Balley we have received, We willing
 that the Error if any be, should in due manner be Corrected and full and Speedy
 Justice to be done to the said Parties in this Behalf. we Command you that if
 Judgment thereof be rendered then the Record and the Proceps of the Judgment
 and Scire facias aforesaid with all things Touching or Concerning the same
 to us in our Upper house of Assembly being the 26th Day of May next
 under your hands and Seals Distinctly and Openly you send that Inspect:
 ion being had of the Records and Proceedings therein We may Cause further
 to be done what of Right and according to the Laws and Constitution of this our Pro:
 vince ought to be done therein and that you Cause the said Raymond Stapleford
