vincial Court held at the City of St. Maries before the Justices of the said Court the 9th
Day of February in the 37th Year of Our Dominion Over Our said Province —
Anno Dom 1668 in a suit depending between Raymond Stapleford Plaintiff
and Jo Bailey Defendant the said Plaintiff recovered against the said Bailey Def^t
Judgment for the sum of 2000^l Sterling and for that Execution hath not therupon
issued. We therefore command you that by good and Lawfull Men of your Baylisick
you make known to the said Jo Bailey that he be before Our Justices of Our next
Provincial Court to be held at the City of St. Maries the 14th Day of April next
to shew cause if any he have why Execution should not issue forth against him
upon the same Judgement & how you shall execute this Writ. Witness our Dear
Son Charles Calvert our Captain General and Chief Justice of Our said Province the
13th Day of February in the 42nd Year & Anno Domini 1673 —
