Moved by a member of this House that the Land given by William Berry to the Inhabitants of Battle Town in Advent County in consideration that the same should be constituted a Town will by the Act of Town passed the last meeting of this Sessions revert... to the Donor the Consideration being taken away unless remedied by a supplementary Act

Voted that the said place a convenient Situation for a Town or Port of Trade and desire that the Lower House will make Provision accordingly in the said Supplementary Act it being the humble request of all the Inhabitants there and divers others in that County the Court House being thereon built at the Great Charge of the County

Voted also that a Town be appointed either at the Land called Mount Cabret or Muffs Shell Bank both convenient Situations for Trade as the Commissioners in the said Act of Trade nominated shall direct to be also Considered in the Supplementary Act

The Lower House is also desired to peruse and Consider of the several Petitions herewith sent them
