

His Lordship presented this House

And moves that by the Act for Support &c. it was enacted that his Lordship's vicarage of noble memory should receive two Shillings for his vicarage during his life and one Crop after and that in the year 1676 his Lordship's now Lord Proprietary had granted him two Shillings for his vicarage by virtue of an Act of Gratitude he received but your Majesty's England was charged by his Lordship's Letter for the two Shillings for his vicarage after the decease of his said Lordship's vicarage & his Lordship affirms that he hath never received the said two Shillings for his vicarage after his Father's decease but hath received the two Shillings for his vicarage granted himself by the Act of Gratitude as his Book of Entries will appear his Lordship desires this House to Certify there was an Act which gave the same to his Lordship and that his Lordship hath never received any more than two Shillings for his vicarage which will plainly appear to this House

Wherewith this House was fully satisfied and vote the drawing up of any Instrument for that purpose to Pass the Great Seal of this Province and be recorded in the Council Book
