You have herewith sent Copy of several Instructions from his Sacred Majesty to his Excellency Recommended to the Consideration of your house And as to his Majestys Royal Instructions concerning a feather supply for the better Support of the Governor his Excellency is pleased to let the House know that as to his own particular Considering how much the Country is in debt and what Absolute Necessity there will be for discharging the same & for the raising of such a fund as shall be answerable to the necessary charge for the Publick Good of this Province he does not insist upon any Particular Addition to what their Majestys have been graciously pleased to allow them
