Proposed that an Addition be made to this Law viz that in Consi-
deration the Parishes being large there be a Greater Number of Vestry
men appointed in each Parish and that the Ministers be one of the said
Vestry in each respective Parish Pursuant to his Majesty's Royal Instruc-
tions & that Church Warden be appointed that Care be taken according
to his Majesty's Instructions likewise for Building of Houses for the
Ministers and to find out a way if possible by Contribution or otherwise
for setting a Glebe in each Parish and building a Chapel of Ease where
Requests and wanting to be done at the Charge and by the Agreement
of the Parishioners & so as they shall see fit

That if a way can be found out to build a House in every parish
for the Ministers his Excellency does propose to give Five Barrels Sterling
towards building every such House begun in his Excellency's time and
his Honour Sir Thomas Laurence Baronet Secretary does likewise pro-
pose that he will give towards the building of the first Ten Houses which
shall be built as aforesaid viz One in each County the sum of 1000 ^{li} Solracco
towards each House and if they find out a way for Glebes his Excellency
does propose to be at the Charge of Surveying the same during his Excellency's
time

That pursuant to his Majesty's Royal Instructions and the right Honble
and Right Reverend the Lord Bishop of London's Proposals it is Recom-
mended that a fitting Competency be found out for his Lordship's Com-
missary to Supervise the Lives and Conversation of the Clergy of this Pro-
vince &c

Col^l Robotham added

That a way be found out for the Building a free school for this Province
and a Maintenance for a School Master and usher and a writing master
that can cast Account

The which if it can be agreed upon his Excellency proposes to give
50 towards building the said School and 25 Sterling a year towards the
Maintenance of the Master during his Excellency's
time

His Honour Sir Thomas Laurence will likewise give 5000 Solracco
