ceived no returns yet of the Indentures from Cecil County pursuant to the  
Act of Assembly of this Province Ordered that Mr. Attorney General make  
due proceedings therein according to law

Col. Hamiltons letter to the late Governor Copley with his proposals  
about the Post Office together with her Majesty's Royal letter in favour  
thereof Esq. Neales Patent for being Post Master General of America and the  
aforesaid Col. Hamiltons Deputation from the said Esq. Neale being produced  
and perused here are recommended to the House of Burgesses for their con-  
sideration

Adjourn till to Morrow morning
