The following Act is recommended to the House to be given to the Law
viz By their Majestys Governour and Council and the Burgesses of this General
Assembly and the Authority thereof

That in the Act for Advancement of Coin in this Province thereof it be said
that the want of ready money in this Province is detrimental to their Majestys
Interest and so consequently to the Good of this Province they proceed to we
That the word Sterling be left out and the Words Current Money put in that piece
of Eight being Seville Mexicos full weight six shillings of 12 weight and every
Penny weight above 12 to be advanced three pence for every penny exceeding
12 Penny weight as aforesaid and every piece of Eight of 12 Penny weight
or above to pass at Five Shillings that all half quarters and sixteenth parts at the
Advanced Value and all half and quarter pieces proportionable to the weight
aforesaid And that there be no Limitation for carrying Money out

As for Paying his Majestys Duties you are referred to his Majestys Royal
Instruction relating thereto before sent you and to consider of an equal Ad-
vance therein and as for the Lord Baltimore you are referred to his Lordshps
Agent

That Old Debts or Bills of Exchange be Advanced proportionably to make
it Money Sterling according to the Advance aforesaid that Officers Fees
be taken in the advanced Coin

The Date must not be ascertained till the Act has passed his Majestys
Royal Assent

That in the Additional Act to the Act of Religion in the 4th line it is
said shall be inducted or collated we are of Opinion that it should be said collated
Inducted or appointed by his Excellency the Governour or Commander in chief
for the time being according to his Majestys Royal Instructions

That a Quarter Number of Vestry men be added proportionable to the Pa-
rishes and the Ministers exempted from any fine according to his Majestys
Royal Instructions

That whereas in the former Act of Religion the Words collated and inducted
are only made use of these Words or appointed by his Excellency the Governour
or Commander in chief for the time being be added and an Addition be made for
the Repair of the Churches and to settle something upon the Church and Sexton &
that Church Wardens be appointed to be chosen according to the Laws of England
