The following Relieverd as they delivered them w^t the page to the
Council who pronounced them that they will send the Slave notice when they
are ready for the Conference.

1st. Habeas in time from the several assemblies they are
ready to admit the slaves to the Conference

The House thereupon resolved themselves into a Grand Committee and
Chose Mr Chevalier Chairman thereof to go up upon the said Conference

The Governor of Virginia coming on the Intervnl caused the said
Conference to be deferred and thereupon they repaired to the State House
again

Whereupon some short time after his Excellency landed his Excellency
produced the following Commission to the Board viz

William & Mary by the Grace of God King and Queen of England
Scotland France and Ireland Defenders of the Faith &c. to our trusty and well
Beloved Sir Edmond Andros Knight our Lieutenant & Governor General of our
Colony and Dominion of Virginia in America Greeting Whereas by our late
imperial Seal of England bearing date the 27th of June in the third
Year of our reign we have thought fit to constitute and appoint our trusty &
well Beloved Lionel Copley Esq our Captain General and Governor in chief for
our said Province and Territory of Maryland in America and whereas by our
Commission under our signet and sign manual we have appointed our trusty
and well Beloved Captain Francis Nicholson to be our Lieutenant Governor of
our said Province and Territory reposing especially confidence in your
Soylty Courage and Circumpection by these presents Constitute & Ap-
point you the said Edmond Andros upon the Death of the said Captain Fran-
cis Nicholson and in the Absence of the said Col^o Lionel Copley to be Comman-
der in Chief in and over our said Province and Territory of Maryland to
have full license and enjoy the Office and Place of Commander in chief
of our said Province and Territory of Maryland for and during our pleasure
with all the Rights Privileges profits and Advantages to the same belonging
and Appertaining in case of the Death of the said Captain Francis Nicholson
and Absence of the said Col^o Lionel Copley as a present with full Powers and
Authority to execute and perform all & singular the Powers and Directives con-
cerned in our said Commission to the said Col^o Lionel Copley
& such Instructions as we have already given shall hereafter from time to time be given
to him and we hereby command all and singular our Officers & Ministers &c.
