

The House of Burgesses message of the 9 of October relating to the State of the
Laws was produced at the Board and taken into consideration and ordered that answer
to the same be drawn up and sent as follows viz⁶

By his Excellency the Governour

October the 11th 1694

The message of your House of the ninth past by Captain Don Major
Dorsey, Mr Hutchinon and Mr Hinson was this day read in Council for
which his Excellency returns you his thanks for the good Opinion the House does
Conceive of him and is willing at present for their Majestys Service & to the end
the Countreys business may not be delayed that the Laws now to be Passed may
run in the same stile as the Laws which were made in Governour Ogleys time
