Act for giving unto all Indians for the defense of this Province and a Clause
be added to the said Act making English masters between that has any information
to make about the incursion or invasion of savage Indians they may be obliged to go to
the next Military Officer or Justice of the Peace where they shall give in their information
the which if it proves true they shall have a Reward of false witness be punished according
to law and that the several Sheriffes make this law known to the several nations of Indians
within this Province

Act for 3d hhd read and passed here

Read an Answer of the House of Burgesses relating to their Majestys Magazine
of Powder &c as follows viz

By the Burgesses of Assembly October 13 1694

Voted that the powder lodged in the state house be equally divided according to the
Taxables in every respective County and the Colonels of each County have the Charge of
the same and that they take care for the Transportation of the same and be allowed them
Charges out of the publick Levy for transporting the same and what publick Charge at
Saint Marys to be equally distributed amongst the Colonels of each respective County
and to be kept in repair at the charge of the several Counties

Voted that whereas the Records of this Province for the Land Office have always
heretofore been kept by the Secretary of this Province and whereas no having no greater
Security for the preservation of the same have thought fit to contain them
formerly by Reason the King has no House of Fortification here

This Board does agree with the House of Burgesses herein and do Order
that the Colonels of each County do take care that the Frontiers be well provided with
Powder Shot and Arms in the first place and that there be not above one Barrel of
Powder lodged in any one place and the same to be kept and preserved unbroken
unless upon insurrection or invasion which God forfend their Majestys having no
publick Store houses here nor fortifications to preserve the same from fire lightning
and other casualties therefore such a distribution is thought most necessary

They do likewise Agree with the Vote of the House as to the Land Records by
Reason their Majestys have no particular place or fort to keep them in

It is ordered for confirming the Act of the last Session of Assembly
it be sent instead of an authentic copy thereof an instrument of sealing a Seal
capulet for repealing certain laws of this Province passed here
